

Missy Elliott proves the perfect complement to the versatile Sheard-Kelly on "Don't Judge Me," a Gospel/hip-hop mashup

Sheard-Kelly's driving force as the creative process began was simple and straightforward: "to be me." Each song, she notes, "is honest and truthful to who I am." Singing professionally since she was nine years old, Sheard-Kelly says she knew beforehand that an album like "Kierra" was in her future. The honest and transparent testimony coursing throughout Kierra is shaped by insightful and relatable lyrics laid against tracks that reflect Sheard-Kelly's love of music. And the album's uplifting music, lyrics and overall message provide a fitting sanctuary during these troubled times.

Kierra is also celebrating the fifth anniversary of her Eleven60 fashion line. The fashion-forward clothing line focuses exclusively on curvy women and is currently available at Macys.com. "Faith and inspiration have been the driving force of my career," notes Sheard-Kelly.

CANDI STATON

In the 1950s, Candi's career began with The Jewel Gospel Trio who recorded for Nashboro Records and toured the world. They were one of the first gospel acts to feature drums and steel guitar. "I saw the Jewel Gospel Singers at the Apollo in New York; these young girls could sing and shout," Aretha Franklin wrote in her autobiography, From These Roots. "I especially liked Canzetta {Candi}, whose voice was filled with feeling.... Many a night Canzetta shook up the service singing 'I Buckled Up My Shoes and Started' or 'Precious Lord.'"

Candi then became a Southern Soul star with "In the Ghetto," and "I'd Rather Be an Old Man's Sweetheart (Than a Young One's Fool)" before becoming a disco diva with "Young Hearts Run Free," "Nights on Broadway," and "Victim."

In the 1980s, Candi birthed a gospel career that has brought her millions of digital streams. "You Got the Love," hit the UK Pop Top Ten charts with various remixes in 1991, 1997, and 2006. It's been featured in a Mercedes Benz commercial and in HBO's "Sex and the City." In 2012, "Hallelujah Anyway," topped club charts in Europe, South Africa, and earned a gold record in Belgium. She's also known for traditional gospel classics such as "Sin Doesn't Live Here Anymore," and "Mama." From 1986-2006, she hosted "New Direction/Say Yes" on the Trinity Broadcasting Network.

In 2008, Candi's "When Will I" was featured in Tyler Perry's film "The Family That Preys" and "When There's Nothing Left But God" was sung by Cassi Davis in his stage show, "Madea's Big Happy Family." Candi's songs have been covered by Vickie Winans, Dorothy Norwood, and The Grace Thrillers, among others. In 2013, she narrated the BBC's acclaimed radio documentary on the song "Amazing Grace." Her 31st album, "In God's Hands," releases this fall.
